

## How to apply to the CSE Certificate

1. Go to <https://admissions.ufl.edu/apply/certificates>
  2. Scroll down and click on "New student application"
  3. Click "Online application"
  4. Create Account or Login
    - a. If you have been a student at UF, you may be able to use your old login and password. If not or if unable to log in, create a new account.
  5. Provide requested Application Information
    - a. Select if you have ever submitted an application to UF.
    - b. For "Attended" pick **YES** (to prevent duplicated UFID) if you previously attended UF.
    - c. Select "Graduate" for the level of your intended certificate program.
  6. Certificate program →  
College of Education → **Computer Science K-12 Teaching** → Fall 2024
  7. Activity → Employment, School, Volunteer, etc.
  8. Pay the \$30 application fee
  9. **Answer the following questions in 150 words or less (each):**
    - a. **Why do you want to be in this certificate program?**

    - b. **How will you ensure that all your students feel included and successful in your CS teaching?**
